Kids Activity Guide – 06/14

Parent Preparation:

Scripture: Isaiah 35:5-6a Acts 3:1-10

Sunday School Tip – Read those scriptures ahead of time and make sure that you have a good grasp of how they relate to the bible point. You should see some correlation between Jesus' words in Matthew and the message of the parable.

Primary Verse: Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf unstopped; then shall the lame man leap like a deer, and the tongue of the mute sing for joy.

Isaiah 35:5-6a

Main Point: Jesus has the power to change our life.

In preparation for talking with your children, ask yourself the question: How do you change your life? Have you ever experienced a miracle? Do you believe in miracles? Why or why not? Do I believe that Jesus has the power to tangibly impact my life? Scripture tells us that Jesus has the power to do miracles and change our life.

Pray: Ask God to help you be patient with your children. Ask him to help you listen to them, Ask for the Holy Spirit to bless your time together, and empower you to help them understand that all of our hope comes from him.

Worship:

Worship is a critical component of helping people understand where we put our hope. By worshiping God, we acknowledge his power over us and elevate him from being "a thing" to someone worthy of our praise, attention, and faith. Worship reminds us that even in uncertainty, God is capable of making a difference in our world.

Sunday School Tip: The more into worship you are, the more encouraging you are, the more likely your kids will get into it and participate.

You can use any Worship music or hymns you would like too, below I have included some links to music videos that we employ in Sunday school.

Say This: Today, we are going to be talking a little about how out how God's power can impact our life. He is alive and he is active in our world and his power is always on display. We're going to start by singing some songs about who God is and how his power impacts our life.

In the Name of Jesus

Say This: Now that you have sung a little bit about God, lets take a look at a story where the power of God mad ea big difference in the lives of some people in our world.

Read This: Acts 3:1-10

Sunday School Tip: I would recommend reading from a kid's bible for this story or sitting down ahead of time and writing the story down in words that your kids might understand. It's a compelling story when told the right way.

Ask: How did God's power make a difference in this story? Whose life was most impacted, Peter or the lame beggar?

The bible reveals to us that God's power was at work in three ways: 1. It told Peter to heal the man, 2. It someone to come to faith in Christ, and 3. It tangibly impacted the life of the blind beggar.


